Public Meeting on South Brandywine Corridor Safety Improvements

Public invited to meeting on proposed S. Brandywine safety improvements

SCHENECTADY – The City of Schenectady will be hosting a public meeting on proposed safety improvements along Brandywine Avenue between I-890 and State Street. The meeting is **Wednesday, September 18, 2019, at 6:00 p.m.** at Tropics Restaurant, 201 S. Brandywine Avenue, Schenectady, NY 12307.

“This section of Brandywine Avenue is one of the busiest corridors in the City, serving as a main cross route perpendicular to I-890, State Street, and Union Street,” said **Mayor Gary McCarthy**. “We encourage residents to participate in the meeting with our Engineering staff to discuss safety improvements along this busy corridor.”

The proposed safety improvements include signal upgrades, pedestrian enhancements, ADA ramps, high-visibility crosswalks, and lane reconfiguration. The City applied for funding and has successfully obtained a \$1.26 million federal grant through the Capital District Transportation Committee to support the project.
