***EXECUTIVE ORDER
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR***

Declaration - State of Emergency

A State of Emergency, having been previously declared effective at 5:00 PM on March 13, 2020, is hereby extended in the City of Schenectady effective at 5:00 PM on April 12, 2020 and will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of the City of Schenectady's residents and visitors. This situation threatens the public health and safety.

The declaration is made to preserve the public health and safety and, I hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this City.

As the Mayor of the City of Schenectady, I, Gary R. McCarthy, exercise the authority given under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of this City. I hereby direct that all persons obey any and all issued Local Emergency Orders through the effective time of this State of Emergency. See attached Local Emergency Order #5.

Further, I hereby direct all departments and bureaus of the City of Schenectady to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and provide such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
