

**2021-2022 PROPOSED ANNUAL ACTION PLAN SUMMARY AND
NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The intent of this notice is to inform citizens of the City of Schenectady that the City's 2021-2022 Proposed Annual Action Plan is available for public comment. These proposed plans are based upon anticipated funding and may change based on the passing of the 2021 Federal Budget by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

In the event, HUD increases or decreases funding for 2021-2022 project year the sub-recipient's applications will be adjusted proportionally based on community needs. All projects will receive a proportional increase or decrease equal to the final allocation. In the case where there is not adequate funding Public Service and Public Work projects may result in not receiving funds. Public comment is welcomed as to how projects will be impacted with an increase or decrease in funding.

The City of Schenectady is the Participating Jurisdiction (PJ) in the Schenectady-Troy-Colonie Consortium of HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funding with the City of Troy and the Town of Colonie. Estimated Funding Availability: \$1,057,515; Funding Allocation: City of Schenectady \$528,757; City of Troy \$423,006; Town of Colonie \$105,751.50.
